DRUM (LEFTY)

REQUIRED CHANNELS: 11

1 BASS DRUM 1 SNARE DRUM 2 RACK TOM 2 FLOOR TOM 2 HI-HAT 2 OVERHEADS 1 DI PASSIVE MONO (BACKING TRACKS)

MONITORING

REQUIRES 1 AUXILIARY SENDS USES PERSONAL IN-EAR MONITORS

GUITAR AND VOICE

REQUIRED CHANNELS: 3 (NO "DI")

1 VOICE (FAKE) 1 TALKBOX 2 Guitar Rack (balanced XLR-Stereo) - No "DI"

MONITORING

Requires 1 auxiliary sends and 1/2 monitor

LEAD VOICE AND GUITAR

REQUIRED CHANNELS: 2 (+1)

1 Voice 1 Acoustic guitar

(1 SPARE MICROPHONE)

MONITORING

Requires 1 auxiliary sends and 1/2 monitors

BASS AND VOICE

REQUIRED CHANNELS: 1 1 VOICE (FAKE) 1 BASS GUITAR RACK (BALANCED XLR)

MONITORING

Requires 1 auxiliary sends and 1/2 monitor

KEYBOARDS AND VOICE

REQUIRED CHANNELS: 2 (NO "DI") 2 Keyboards - NO "DI" 1 Voice (FAKE)

MONITORING

Requires 1 Auxiliary sends and 1 monitor

TOTAL REQUIRED CHANNELS: 20 ADDITIONAL REQUIREMENTS

- PLATFORMS FOR DRUMS AND KEYBOARDS
- 8/10 BOTTLES OF WATER OF STAGE DURING OUR PERFORMANCE


In the case of an open-air concert, the organization must provide a waterproof cover for instruments for rain. If one or more opening bands are scheduled for the event. Bad Medicine members are not available to lend any instrument or appliance unless agreed differently at contract stipulation time.

Therefore opening bands must provide their own instrumentation (drums and amplifiers) that will be dismounted and removed from the stage before Bad Medicine's performance.

- Hot meal catering for 7 band members and vegan food for one band member.
- Food and drinks for 7 members of the band delivered to dressing room.
- Dressing Room big enough for 6 people to change, Private Bathroom if possible.
- Bottles of water will be required at all events.

ON ARRIVAL AT THE VENUE: Please note:

- This section is only if the band are arrive 2 hours before the show to set up and Sound Check.
- Dressing Room big enough for 6 people
- A hot meal or sandwiches for the band and crew members
- Soft drinks, bottles of water and beer

BAND ROOM REQUIREMENTS:

- We do not ask for a luxury suite however a clean, dry, private and secure dressing room we need.
- Several hours between sound check and show times the band need a suitable place to relax
