### Personnel:

- 5 Band Members
- 2/3 Dancers (as specified per show)

## **Beverages:**

- One crate of bottled beer (24 bottles)
- Two 1-liter bottles of Coca-Cola or equivalent
- Two 1-liter bottles of Fanta or equivalent
- Five cans of Red Bull or similar energy drink
- Twelve 0.5-liter bottles of non-carbonated water (accessible both before and during the performance)
- Unlimited access to coffee and tea
- Ten drink tokens per person, if applicable

### Food:

- A hot meal for each band and crew member
- One hot meal option **without** pork
- If a hot meal cannot be provided, a meal buy-out option of €10 per person is required, in addition to the agreed performance fee
- A selection of fresh fruits


# **Dressing Room & Body Paint Needs**

- **Private Space**: A secure, enclosed area for changing and makeup application.
- **Large Mirror**: Well-lit for proper makeup application.
- **Seating Area**: At least a few chairs and a table.

# **Essential Facilities for Guitarist (Full Body Paint):**

- *Sink with cold water* (for pre-show touch-ups).
- *Shower with hot + cold water* (very important for removing body paint).
- At least five towels (for makeup removal and post-show drying).

In makeup Final result





- **Warm-up Area**: A designated space for the bassist and guitarist to prepare before going on stage.
- **Adjacent Near-Stage Space**: To set up equipment before the performance, allowing for quick changeovers and sound checks.
- **Advance Communication**: If any of these facilities are unavailable, the venue should inform the band beforehand so they can prepare accordingly.

### **General Notes:**

Limp Business is comprised of grounded individuals who hold great respect for all venues and their staff or volunteers. Our backstage and catering rider is straightforward with minimal specific demands. We trust that these requirements will be met with mutual respect.
